### **Regular Meeting Minutes**

#### August 15, 2019

The Board of Directors of the Midland County Utility District met in a regular meeting on August 15, 2019 at 2405 West Missouri Avenue, Midland, Texas 79701. The meeting was held pursuant to notice given to the public in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas. The meeting was open to the public.

- Item 2. Dr. Viney announced that a quorum was present.
- Item 3. No members of the public wished to speak.
- Item 4. Dr. Viney called Item 4 on the Agenda. Mr. Rodriquez made a motion to approve the Minutes of the June 25, 2019 meeting which was seconded by Mr. Schneider and passed unanimously.
- Item 5. Mr. Bain reviewed the financials with the Board. After discussion Mr. Schneider made a motion to approve the finical report and approve payment of bills and invoices attached hereto. The motion was seconded by Mr. Lang and unanimously approved.
- Item 6. Jay Edwards provided a report to the Board in regard to the District activities. He reported that discussions continue with the City of Midland and CRMWD regarding transport of water in the District.

- Item 7. Mr. Edwards advised the Board that only Weaver & Tidwell LLC had responded to the Request for Proposal for Audit Service for the 2019-2020 fiscal period. Since the current auditor did not respond to the Request for Qualifications, the Board deferred any action until a committee composed of Dr. Viney and Alan Lang could review the response from Weaver & Tidwell LLC.
- Mr. Edwards advised the Board that Meyers & Ward and Rendall Sikes PLLC Item 8. had responded to the Request for Qualifications for Legal Services for the 2019-2020 fiscal period. Leah Robertson of Meyers & Ward discussed with the Board the qualification of her firm to handle the legal needs for the District. After discussion the Board deferred action until a committee composed of Dr. Viney and Alan Lang could review the responses to the Request for Qualifications.
- Mr. Bain discussed a proposed budget for the 2019-2020 fiscal year. After Item 9. discussion, Mr. Lang made a motion to approve the Budget, as attached hereto. Mr. Schneider seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.
- Item 10. Mr. Rendall presented the Certified Valuations from the Midland Central Appraisal District and discussed tax rate options with the Board. After discussion, a motion to advertise in accordance with state law a proposed rate of \$ 0.027302 per \$ 100.00 of valuation and to hold a public hearing on the proposed tax rate on September 19, 2019 at 5:30 p.m. at 2405 W. Missouri Ave., Midland, Texas was made by Mr. Lang. Mr. Rodriguez seconded the motion and it was approved unanimously.
- Item 11. Mr. Rendall advised the Board he had been in discussion with Midland County regarding documentation of the District's authority to use County Right of Way for pipeline construction. Mr. Rendall advised that until an agreement was in place with Midland County, the District could not move forward on agreement with Permian Basin Water for its proposed development within the District.
- Item 12. Mr. Rendall gave a brief summary of legislation approved during the last legislative session which could impact the District.
- Mr. Edwards discussed the District's website and e-mail system. The Board Item 13. discussed the necessity for all communication between Board Members and the District's General Manager, accountant and legal counsel to be conducted through the District's system. Mr. Rendall reminded the Board it should not communicate as a group through the e-mail system so as to not be in violation of the Texas Open Meeting Act.
- **Item 14.** Mr. Rendall provided the Board with information regarding a possible bond election in May of 2020.
- Item 15. The Board did not recess into Executive Session.

- Dr. Viney announced the next regular meeting of the Board would take place on Thursday, September 19, 2019 at 5:30 p.m subject to call of the President.
- The meeting was adjourned at 6:19 p.m. Item 17.
