| 551.074 | For the purpose of considering the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment of duties, discipline, or dismissal of a public officer or employee. |

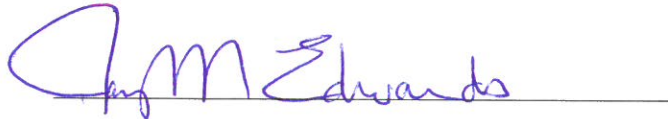
## ACTION ITEMS
